ISSUE #1 EXAMPLE

Global Hunger

- 1 to 2 sentences about the issue of concern. Why do you care about it?
EXAMPLE – As Catholics, we are very concerned about the millions of children around the world who don't have enough to eat and suffer from malnutrition.
- 1 to 2 sentences stating what you would like your member of Congress to do about the issue. Reference specific legislation, with full title and bill number, if relevant.
EXAMPLE A – Please support robust funding for school lunch programs so poor and vulnerable children around the world have a better chance to receive nutritious meals and will be ready to learn.
EXAMPLE B – Please support H.R. 123, the Global Nutrition Act, which provides \$250 million for school lunch programs for children in some of the poorest countries around the world.
- Describe why your member of Congress' actions could make a difference.
EXAMPLE – Catholic Relief Services currently provides school lunches to 1,000 children in a community in Kenya. As a result, girls' school attendance is up by 30%, and overall absences have declined by 50%. Your leadership on providing additional school lunches for poor and vulnerable children will build support in Congress for robust funding for school lunches—and build a brighter future for children in need around the world.

ISSUE #2 EXAMPLE

Comprehensive Immigration Reform

- Describe the issue and why you care about it.
- What would you like the member of Congress to do? (the "ask")
- Share information about the Church's work on immigration and how it makes a difference.
